Her Coach for all 3 years, Megan Almand, and in 8th grade, Jessica Nesom, helped shape her to become the ball player she was... with lots of practice. Addison lived for basketball, and you rarely caught her without a basketball in her hands. She

also played AAU basketball for LA Fusion under coaches Silas Lee and Mike Watts where her skills greatly improved. She loved a variety of music and taught herself to play the keyboard and guitar. She loved traveling and most recently got to visit New England, where she planned to move to Boston someday. When she had free time from basketball practice, she loved talking to her best friends, Nat, Lily, Mia, Larkyn and Nicole. She loved being outdoors skateboarding, hiking, fishing, swimming, riding her BMX bike... the girl loved to do it all. She had a natural gift of making people laugh with her dry, sarcastic sense of humor. She always tried to make others feel included. She was the light of her momma's eyes, or as she liked to call her, "my emo birth giver," and loved telling her the latest teenage drama going on or asking for a new pair of shoes (that she always managed to convince her mom, or Maw Maw Freda, she needed). She was her dad's late night gym partner, and basketball opponent at home, and received her funny sense of humor from her father. Her brother Wyatt looked up to her and would let you know she was the best basketball player there was. Her, "Sissy Ava," was her best friend and thought the absolute world of her. She believed Addison was the strongest, most confident person she had ever met. They both miss their sissy more than words can express and would give anything to have her back. Addison has a Quaker parrot, "Venus," two German Shepherds, "Ratchet" and "Savage", a black cat, "Nyla" and two mixed Siamese kittens she shared with Ava, "Roombus" and "Iris," or as Addison called her, "Burnt Hotdog." Addison was an extremely smart, confident, beautiful, talented and hilarious young woman. Her family was very close and spent time daily together. Addison had a personality that could light up an entire room, mostly from laughter because her sense of humor was unlike any others. She needed the kind of "peace that surpasses all understanding" and she got that in the arms of Jesus, and our Blessed
