



Alvin 'Bud' Amman

October 1, 1928 - September 29, 2023

Alvin (Bud) Amman died peacefully at the Phoenix Memory Care facility in Hammond, Louisiana on September 29, 2023, at the age of 95. He is survived by his daughter, Jill Amman of Issaquah, Washington; son, Joe Amman of Denham Springs, Louisiana; nieces, Mary Brannaman of Sheridan, Wyoming and Mindy Bower of Kiowa, Colorado; and nephews, Bill Bower of Abilene, Kansas and Jim Bower of Arvada, Colorado. After the passing of his wife of 70 years in August of 2022 he was moved by his son to Hammond, Louisiana, to be cared for as a result of suffering from Vascular Senility.
