Her hair was never out of place, and she maintained weekly hair appointments her entire life. She also loved to watch Westerns, loved to cook, loved to dance, and attend church events. She was very strong in her faith, and would never go to bed without reading her Bible and saying her prayers. She was grateful that God had given her a clear mind and a strong spirit and looked forward to one day reuniting and rejoicing with her family in heaven. When people asked her what the secret was to her long life, she said it was

the advice her beloved mother had given her. She told her not to worry about anything, to help the things you could help, and leave the rest alone. It was ok to "be concerned", but better to let God take care of things, and besides that, worrying gave you wrinkles! Her mother also taught her and her three sisters to love each other all the time no matter what, and that love was the most important thing that anyone could share with you. She was preceded in death by her husband of 32 years Wallace D. Walker, her parents, Haney Guy and Mattie Forbes Mondart, her beloved son Charles Earl Roberts, and her sisters who were her best friends and their spouses, Lou Digirolamo (Joe), Thelma Tridico Bush, and Gayle Passman (John).
