Glenn "Carlton" Ellis, born on November 14, 1936, in Walker, Louisiana, and passed away peacefully at his home on May 9, 2026, surrounded by his family and friends.

Carlton is survived by his devoted wife of 59 years and 11 months, Ann "Sherri" Muse Ellis; his daughter, Kelli Ellis and his son, Derek Ellis and his wife Cori.

A man of deep faith, Carlton was a lifelong and active member of Walker Baptist Church. His journey with the church began when he was placed on the church's "Cradle Roll" at just two weeks old. Throughout his life, he faithfully served the Lord and his church in many capacities, including as a deacon. His commitment to his faith and church family remained steadfast throughout his life.

Carlton graduated from Walker High School in 1955 and proudly served his country in the Louisiana National Guard for six years. He earned a bachelor's degree from Southeastern Louisiana University and later completed a master's plus 30 degree in Education from Louisiana State University.

He dedicated 37 years of service to the Livingston Parish Public School System, where he served as a teacher, coach, and principal. He retired as an

educational administrator from the Central Office. His influence on students, educators, and the community will be remembered for generations.

Carlton loved spending time with his family and friends and found great joy in serving his community and church. He had a lifelong passion for sports, especially baseball and softball. He enjoyed playing fast-pitch softball for many years, coaching young athletes, and cheering on LSU Baseball, attending most every home game for nearly 30 years.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Glenn and Larrecie Ellis; sisters, Geraldine "Jerry" Ellis Varnado and Janice Ellis Tiner; and brothers, Leslie and Douglas Ellis.
