It is with deep sorrow that we announce the passing of Walter William Bazar on April 13, 2026. He was born on August 10, 1976, to Joseph A. B. Bazar and Norma Jean Johnson Bazar. He was 49 years old. In his younger years, Walter worked as a lineman with Diamond B Construction Company, overlaying roads. He also worked as a helper with a survey company. He later started his own yard maintenance business, cutting yards in Walker, Denham Springs, and Baton Rouge. Many people fondly knew him as "the best yard man they ever had." In 2002 he started his dirt, sand, and gravel business. Walter was an excellent heavy equipment operator who cleared land, built house pads, and dug ponds throughout Livingston Parish. Walter was an avid outdoorsman, he was always in the woods hunting, or out on the water in one of his boats, fishing. He had an affinity for cooking jambalaya, gumbo, and pastalaya, and lent his talents to many cookoffs, church functions, benefits, and fundraisers. He was loved by those that knew him and will be greatly missed.
