



## Walter E. Daisey

August 1, 1955 - July 6, 2021

Retired Assistant Chief of Walker Police, Walter E. Daisey died July 6, 2021, at his residence in Walker, LA at the age of 65. Walter was born August 1, 1955, in Lewis, Delaware, he was a U.S. Army Veteran and a longtime law enforcement officer with 33 years of service. He was a Louisiana DPS, and Capitol Police Officer for 13 years, and served with the City of Walker Police Department for over 20 years including service as a Louisiana K-9 officer, and Assistant Chief before retirement.
