



Wanda Rose Brown

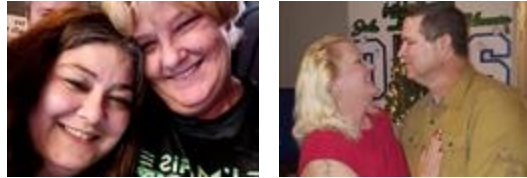
March 22, 1968 - January 10, 2022

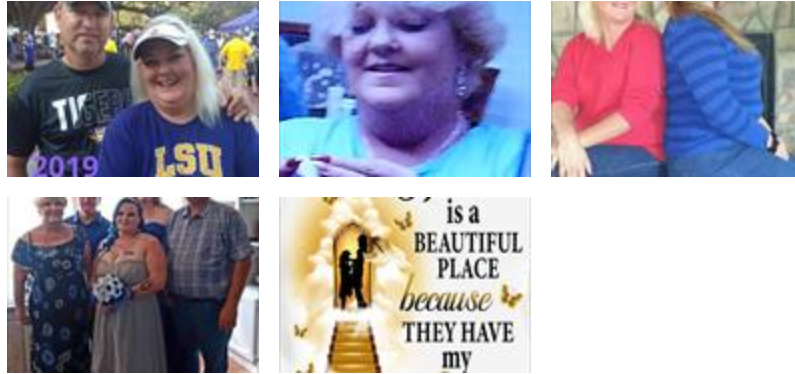
